Guideline for Carriage of Samsung Galaxy Note 7 Mobile Phone On Board an Aircraft

In response to the recent information from civil aviation authorities of some countries on restrictions or recommendations on the carriage of Samsung Galaxy Note 7 mobile phone on board an aircraft,

In order to create common understanding and prevent safety risk on aircraft, passenger and property on board, the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand hereby issue the following guideline:

1. The passengers are not allowed to put Samsung Galaxy Note 7 mobile phone in the baggage to be delivered to the air operator as the checked baggage.

2. The passengers can carry Samsung Galaxy Note 7 mobile phone on board. However, the device must be turned off and cannot be charged while on board the aircraft.

3. The passengers must inform the cabin crew immediately when the device is damaged, overheat, produces smoke, is lost or falls into the seat structure.

All air operators shall inform the passengers and the crew of the above guideline. The cabin crew shall also make on board public announcement of the guideline to the passengers.
