



Ministerial Regulation
Prescribing Rules and Procedures for Transfer
a Type Certificate or Supplemental Type Certificate
B.E. 2553

By virtue of Section 6 (5) and the second paragraph of Section 41/12 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 as amended by the Air Navigation Act (No. 11) B.E. 2551, which is a law containing provisions which restrict the rights and liberties of the people, and given that Section 29, in conjunction with Sections 32, 34, 41, and 43 of the Constitution of Thailand, grants the authority to prescribe restrictions on the rights and liberties by virtue of the law, the Minister of Transport hereby issues the following regulation:

Article 1. The transfer of a Type Certificate or Supplemental Type Certificate. The transferor or the receiver transfer shall submit an application to the Director General using the form as prescribed and notified by the Director General within 30 days from the date of transfer together with the following documents and evidence:

(1) In case of the transferor or the receiver transfer is a natural person holding Thai nationality shall attached a copy of an ID or another document which issued by the Government services using as a substitute of an ID. If the transferor or the receiver transfer is a foreigner shall attached a copy of a foreigner ID or passport. If the transferor or the receiver transfer is a Juristic person shall attached a copy of an approved letter or evidence to show being a Juristic person which indentifying the currently of the name, purpose, office location, and the name list of committees, managers, or a person who having been duly authorized to sign on behalf of the juristic person.

(2) The Type Certificate or Supplemental Type Certificate which shall be transferred.

(3) The contract agreement for transfer a Type Certificate or supplemental Type Certificate or the evidence concerning inheritor.

(4) Other documents and evidences as prescribed by the Director General

Article 2. Upon receiving the application together with the documents and evidences under Article 1 completely. The Director General shall examine the accuracy and completeness of those documents and evidences. Upon finding that the submitted documents and evidences are accuracy and completeness. The Director General shall record the transfer of a Type Certificate or Supplemental Type Certificate by identifying the details which concerned and necessary as one see.
