

Regulation of the Civil Aviation Board

No. 67

Relating to personnel discipline

---

By virtue of Section 15(2) and Section 49 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497, the Civil Aviation Committee, upon the Transport Minister's approval, is authorized to stipulate regulations relating to personnel discipline as follows;

**Clause 1.** Under this regulation;

“Psychoactive substances” means alcohol, opioids, cannabinoids, sedatives and hypnotics, cocaine, other psychostimulants, hallucinogens, and volatile solvents, whereas coffee and tobacco are excluded.

**Clause 2.** Personnel shall not use one or more psychoactive substances in a way that;

- (1) Constitutes a direct hazard to the user or endangers the lives, health or welfare of others; and/or
- (2) Causes or worsens an occupational, social, mental or physical problem or disorder.

**Clause 3.** Personnel shall not perform its duties while;

- (1) Being under the influence of any psychoactive substance which deteriorates its capabilities.
- (2) Using psychoactive substances at least 8 hours before performs its duties.

**Clause 4.** Personnel shall not perform its duties beyond the specified rights under Civil Aviation Committee's regulation.

**Clause 5.** Personnel on duty shall communicate and operate in polite and proper manners.

**Clause 6.** Personnel shall not forsake its duties during the operation period without reasonable causes.

**Clause 7.** Personnel performing as a pilot-in-command shall;

- (1) Strictly comply with the Aircraft Flight Manual and Flight Operation Manual approved by director-general of Department of Civil Aviation.
- (2) Record the journey log book and aircraft log book to its actuality while operating the flight or after the flight immediately.

**Clause 8.** Aircraft maintenance personnel shall certify airworthiness or aircraft maintenance only under its inspection providing that the personnel shall record such operation to its actuality immediately.

**Clause 9.** This regulation shall have effect from the date of announcement in the Royal Gazette onwards.
