

Notification of the Department of Civil Aviation

Re: Flight Crew Member Training Program - Airplane

(Issue 2), B.E. 2553

According to Notification of the Department of Civil Aviation of the Flight Crew Member Training Program – Airplane, given on 29 April B.E. 2553 which stipulates a guideline for training Flight Crews – aeroplane owned by certified Flight Crews, the Department of Civil Aviation, for the purpose of ensuring conformity of selecting individual flight Crew with the aforesaid Notification, issues the Notification as follows:

Clause 1. Clause 4 (3) regarding School Flight on paragraph which stipulates that “Flight Crew – Aeroplane must obtain flights and/or flying hours as prescribed and shall pass the examination from the Department of Civil Aviation or individual who is appointed to become Designated Check Pilot by the Department of Civil Aviation to the extent described in Appendix 5 attached at the end of this Notification within 1 year, counting from the time recorded the Type Rating in the individual Flight Crew license – Airplane”, shall be To be repealed and replaced by the following statement:

“Flight Crew – Airplane must obtain flights and/or flying hours within 1 year as prescribed, counting from the time recorded the Type Rating in the individual Flight Crew license – Airplane and shall pass the examination from the Line Check Pilot who is appointed by certified Flight Crew. The examination shall comply with the defined scopes on the Checklist as described in Appendix 5 attached at the end of this Notification. Flight Operator must inform the examination results of individual Flight Crew - Airplane to the Department of Civil Aviation.

Clause 2. This notification shall come into force as from 29 April B.E. 2553 onwards.
