

Guidelines for Completing Form AIR/AR-101

Application for registration of registration mark



WHO SHOULD COMPLETE THIS FORM

The owner or possessor of the aircraft, who will become the registration holder, should complete this form.

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM

Section 1 Registration Mark

This section is MANDATORY if a registration mark has been reserved for the aircraft - If there is a registration mark currently reserved by the applicant for use on the aircraft, insert that registration mark here. If a mark has not been reserved by the applicant for use on the aircraft, leave Section 1 blank and CAAT will assign the next available mark to your aircraft.

Note: You must first reserve a registration mark before you can apply to use that registration mark on an aircraft. Use [Form AIR-AR-001](#) to reserve a registration mark.

Section 2 Aircraft Details

MANDATORY Fields - for aircraft with a Type Certificate,

- Type of certificate no.
- Name and address of Manufacturer
- Aircraft Type and Model
- Aircraft Manufacture's Serial Number
- Date of manufacture (Month/Year)
- Maximum Take Off Weight (in kilograms)
- Engine Type and Model, Number of Engine
- Name and address of owner

MANDATORY Fields – for aircraft WITHOUT a Type Certificate,

- Name and address of Manufacturer
- Aircraft Type and Model
- Aircraft Manufacture's Serial Number
- Date of manufacture (Month/Year)
- Engine Type and Model, Number of Engine
- Name and address of owner

If the aircraft has been registered before please specify the country and registration mark. Please specify aircraft parking place e.g. Hangar or Airport.

Section 3 Applicant details

Insert the name and address of person who intended to be register holder as specify: Owner or Possessor.

Section 4 Ultra-light aircraft

Please specify name of member of Flying/Club/Group/Foundation/ Government Unit/State enterprise.
