POSTING OF SIGNIFICANT SECURITY CONCERN (SSeC)

1. The Council, at the third meeting of its 189th Session, approved a mechanism for addressing Significant Security Concerns (SSeCs) identified during the conduct of audits under the ICAO Universal Security Audit Programme (USAP). The approved mechanism requires notification of the existence of unresolved SSeCs on the USAP secure website (<https://portal.icao.int/usap>).
2. This bulletin serves to advise ICAO Member States that a new posting pertaining to the existence of one SSeC in the Federated States of Micronesia has been made on the website. Currently, a total of eight identified SSeCs remain unresolved for all States audited under the USAP since the implementation of the mechanism. The complete list of States with unresolved SSeCs is posted on the USAP secure website, together with the date of initial posting and the affected audit area(s) where the SSeC has been outstanding for more than three months.
3. To obtain additional information relating to the SSeCs, States are invited to refer to Recommended Practice 2.4.5 of Annex 17 — *Security* regarding the principles pertaining to the sharing of ICAO USAP audit results.
