
Receipt of the Report, Receipt of the Notification, Disembarkation or Delivery of a Person for Prosecution in the Kingdom and Conducting a Preliminary Enquiry into Facts



make a report in writing on:

- Date
- Time

When the aircraft landed.

- identity of person
- Information concerned

4.1 Case of Disembarkation The CO verifies whether the State of Registration is a Contracting State of Tokyo Convention 1963 or not:

- Yes --Allow disembarkation
- No -- Not allow disembarkation and follow the law on immigration



Aircraft In-Flight, Notify before landing, whether to:

- disembark or
- deliver











1. PIC* with intention to disembark or deliver a person notifies the CO# by radio communication.

3. PIC makes a report on the facts and the reason for his intention to disembark or deliver the person for prosecution.

4. PIC submits the report and disembark or deliver the person to the CO

The CO records the receipt.











(2) submits notification in writing to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) so that MFA shall notify:

the detained person

Any other interested State










(1) immediately notifies the CO to conduct the preliminary enquiry into the facts.



If yes, follow (1), and (2).

If no, delivery shall be denied.

5. If the detained person wants to communicate with the Representative (e.g. the Royal Embassy), the CO will assist in such communication.

6.The CO conducts preliminary enquiry into the facts for considering whether:

- the person delivered committed an unlawful acts on board or not and

- criminal proceeding can be intituted or not

6.2 If the results show that **no** criminal proceedings can be **instituted**, and no request for extradition, the CO shall:

- enable the person's journey from

the Kingdom or

- if he has the right to entry into the Kingdom, release him from custody

6.1 If the results show that criminal proceedings can be **instituted**, the CO shall:

- deliver such person to an inquiry official and

 submit notification in writing with report of PIC and enquiry results to MFA and

submit their copies to CAAT

NOTES:

* PIC= Pilot-in-Command # CO = Competent Official with power in that area, please see Announcement of the Royal Thai Police Re: Appointment of the Competent Officials for more information.
