Subject: Guidance material and training program for runway pavement, maintenance and operations for Aerodrome operator

For the attention of: Aerodrome operator

Purpose:

The purpose of this safety bulletin is to enhance runway safety measures by providing guidance material and training program for runway pavement, maintenance and operations, aligning with international standards and best practices, as recognized by both the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) and the International Civil Aviation Organization's Regional Aviation Safety Group – Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC).

Introduction:

The Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) understands the need for runway safety. As a part of its efforts, CAAT has included actions in the Thailand Aviation Safety Action Plan to address this. Additionally, the International Civil Aviation Organization's Regional Aviation Safety Group – Asia and Pacific Regions (RASG-APAC) is also taking action. RASG-APAC has approved guidance material and training program for runway pavement, maintenance and operations from aerodrome operator's perspective. This action is aimed at reducing the risk of runway issues. By providing aerodrome operators with clear guidance and training opportunities through courses and seminars, these steps align with international standards in Annex 14 SARPs and reflect best practices in the industry.
