

Summary of Practical Guidelines for Air Operators		
Phase	Air Operators' Duties	
	Foreign Nationals	Thai Nationals Returning to Thailand
Upon Check-in	<ol> <li>Verify passengers' travel history in the last 14 days before the date of travel whether they have traveled to Disease Infected Zone or Ongoing Local Transmission Area</li> <li>If yes, require the presentation of;         <ul> <li>Health certificate certifying that the passengers "pose no risk of being infected by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)", issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel.</li> <li>Health insurance/health insurance policy that shows minimum medical coverage of 100,000 USD in Thailand and covers the Covid-19 Disease</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Require the presentation of "Fit to Fly" health certificate</li> <li>Certifying Letter from Royal Thai Embassy, Thai Consulate Office or Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Kingdom of Thailand</li> </ol>
	Note: If the passenger has traveled to Disease Infected Zone or Ongoing Local Transmission Area, or is unable to present the required above documents, the air operator shall not issue a boarding pass and the boarding shall be denied.	Note: If the passenger is unable to present the required above documents, the air operator shall not issue a boarding pass and the boarding shall be denied.
Upon Receiving Boarding Pass	<ol> <li>Arrange seats to passengers with the greatest possible distance apart from each other when issuing boarding passes</li> <li>Arrange for passengers to provide information on the address in Thailand in the T.8 Form or in "AOT Airport of Thailand" Application.</li> </ol>	
On Board	<ol> <li>Inform passengers on how to protect themselves from communicable diseases, such as wearing masks at all time.</li> <li>Limit services in the passenger cabin</li> <li>Require all flight attendants to wear masks</li> </ol>	
Entry to Thailand (Passenger's Duty)	<ol> <li>Present to the communicable disease control official:         <ul> <li>(1) Health Certificate / Insurance Policy</li> <li>(2) Completed T8 Form or "AOT Airport of Thailand" Application</li> </ul> </li> <li>Under the applicable appropriate quarantine measure</li> </ol>	Present the T.8 Form to the communicable disease control official     days self-quarantine at their own residence
