REQUIREMENT OF THE CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY OF THAILAND

No. 50

RE: DESIGNATION OF AN AIRCRAFT OWNER, AIRCRAFT REGISTRANT,
OR AIR OPERATOR TO COLLECT PASSENGER SERVICE CHARGES
ON BEHALF OF THE LICENSED AERODROME OWNER OR OPERATOR

By virtue of Section 6/1 and Section 60/41 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 (1954), amended by the Emergency Decree to Amend the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 B.E. 2558, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand hereby issues requirement to designate an aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator to collect passenger service charges on behalf of the licensed aerodrome owner or operator, as follows:

Article 1 The Requirement shall be called “Requirement of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand No. 50 RE: designation of an aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator to collect passenger service charges on behalf of the licensed aerodrome owner or operator”.

Article 2 This Requirement shall enter into force from the day following its publication in the Government Gazette onwards.

Article 3 The Ministerial Regulation establishing the criteria and procedures for designating the aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator as the entity responsible for collecting passenger service charges B.E. 2552, given on 21 of December B.E. 2552 is hereby repealed.

Article 4 The aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator shall be responsible for collecting the passenger service charges on behalf of the licensed aerodrome owner or operator, and shall be entitled to receive remuneration for the collection from the licensed aerodrome owner or operator as mutually agreed.

Article 5 Passenger service charges shall be collected together with air fare, with the service charge rate clearly stated on the ticket or any other document that itemizes the charges to be paid by the passenger.

Article 6 The aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator shall remit the passenger service charges collected to the licensed aerodrome owner or operator before the aircraft departs.

In cases where the aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator has the following characteristics, the remittance of the collected passenger service charges to the licensed aerodrome owner or operator must be made within the period specified in Article 7;

(1) The operator holds an air operator certificate with its principal place of business or permanent residence located within the Kingdom; or

(2) The operator holds a foreign air operator certificate and provides scheduled or non-scheduled charter services authorised to operate for a specified period, and has a branch office located within the Kingdom or an agent responsible for the collection and remittance of the passenger service charges within the Kingdom; or

(3) The foreign air operator provides scheduled services and does not have a branch office in the Kingdom or an agent responsible for the collection and remittance of the passenger service charges within the Kingdom but has deposited a prepayment with the licensed aerodrome owner or operator in accordance with the conditions established by the licensed aerodrome owner or operator.

Article 7 The aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator as specified in Article 6, paragraph two, shall remit the passenger service charges within the following timeframes;

(1) Passenger service charges collected between the 1st and the 15th of the month must be remitted by the last day of that month.

(2) Passenger service charges collected between the 16th and the last day of the month must be remitted by the 15th of the following month.

Article 8 The aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator as specified in Article 6, paragraph one, shall provide a list of passengers, duly signed by the responsible party, along with the collected passenger service charges to the licensed aerodrome owner or operator before the aircraft departs.

For the aircraft owner, aircraft registrant, or air operator as specified in Article 6, paragraph two, the list of passengers, duly signed by the responsible party, along with the collected passenger service charges, must be submitted to the licensed aerodrome owner or operator by the day following the aircraft's departure.
