

Royal Decree Revising Limits of Liability of a Carrier  
under the Law on International Carriage by Air  
B.E. 2568

His Majesty King Maha Vajiralongkorn Phra Vajiraklaochaoyuhua is graciously pleased to proclaim that:

Whereas it is expedient to revise limits of liability of a carrier under the law on international carriage by air;

By virtue of Section 175 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand and Section 7 of the International Carriage by Air Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the Royal Decree is enacted by His Majesty the King as follows:

Section 1 This Royal Decree shall be called “Royal Decree Revising Limits of Liability of a Carrier under the Law on International Carriage by Air B.E. 2568.”

Section 2 This Royal Decree shall come into force on the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Section 3 The Royal Decree Revising Limits of Liability of a Carrier under the Law on International Carriage by Air B.E. 2563 shall be repealed.

Section 4 Limits of liability of a carrier under the International Air Carriage Act B.E. 2558 (2015) shall be revised as follows:

(1) Limits of liability of the carrier under Section 14 in a case of damage sustained from death or bodily injury of a passenger shall be revised to be one hundred and fifty-one thousand eight hundred and eighty Special Drawing Rights for each passenger;

(2) Limits of liability of the carrier under Section 15 in a case of damage occasioned by delay in carriage of passengers shall be revised to be six thousand three hundred and three Special Drawing Rights for each passenger;

(3) Limits of liability of the carrier under Section 16 in a case of destruction, loss, damage of baggage or its delay shall be revised to be one thousand five hundred and nineteen Special Drawing Rights for each passenger;

(4) Limits of liability of the carrier under Section 39 in a case of destruction, loss, or damage of cargo or its delay shall be revised to be twenty-six Special Drawing Rights per kilogram.

Section 5 The Minister of Transport shall be responsible for the enforcement of this Royal Decree.
