Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand
Re.: Passenger Service Charges to Be Collected
at Licensed Aerodromes Opened for Public
B.E. 2567 (2024)

Since Section 56, paragraph 1 (1) of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 (1954), as amended by the Air Navigation Act (No. 11) B.E. 2551 (2008) prescribes that an owner or operator of a licensed aerodrome opened for public is able to collect passenger service charges according to Chapter 6 *bis*, the owner or the operator of such public licensed aerodrome shall collect passenger service charges, provided that an approval of the Minister of Transport has been granted upon an advisory of the Civil Aviation Board under Section 60/37, paragraph 2 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 (1954), as amended by the Air Navigation Act (No. 11) B.E. 2551 (2008). The Minister of Transport, then, issued a Notification of the Ministry of Transport repealing two Ministry's Notifications, namely the Notification of the Ministry of Transport, Re.: Passenger Service Charges to Be Collected at Licensed Aerodromes Opened for Public B.E. 2560 (2017), Notified o 26 April 2017, and the Notification of the Ministry of Transport, Re.: Passenger Service Charges to Be Collected at Licensed Aerodromes Opened for Public (No.2) B.E. 2566 (2023), Notified on 31 October 2026. Also, the Minister of Transport issued an order on 2 May 2024 attached to the letter No. 0202/374 dated 25 April 2024 of the Legal Division, the Office of Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Transport to appoint the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand to issue a notification to publicize recent rates of the passenger service charges to be collected at each public licensed aerodrome as approved by the Minister of Transport upon the advisory of the Civil Aviation Board under Section 60/37, paragraph 2 of the Air Navigation Act B.E. 2497 (1954) and its amendments because the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand as a regulatory organization is entrusted with powers and duties to regulate, control, promote civil aviation activities to be efficient, and effective as well as a center for providing information, data, and public relations relating to civil aviation activities. Therefore, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand issues the Notification as follows:

Article 1 This Notification shall be cited as “the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand, Re.: Passenger Service Charges to Be Collected at Licensed Aerodromes Opened for Public B.E. 2567 (2024).”

Article 2 Passenger Service Charges shall be collected at licensed aerodromes opened for public under the following rates per passenger:

(1) for each international departure at the following aerodromes:

(a) * aerodromes under responsibility of

Airports of Thailand Public Company Limited: not over 1,120.-Thai baht;

(b) Samui Airport: not over 700.- Thai baht;

(c) Sukhothai Airport: not over 500.- Thai baht;

(d) †Krabi Airport, Surat Thani Airport,

Ubon Ratchathani Airport, Khon Kaen Airport,

Nakhon Si Thammarat Airport, and

Phitsanulok Airport: not over 425.- Thai baht;

(e) ‡other aerodromes under responsibility of

Department of Airports, except for

Betong Airport; and other aerodromes besides

those specified in (a), (b), (c), and (d): not over 400.- Thai baht;

Airports of Thailand Public Company Limited: not over 130.-Thai baht;

(b) Samui Airport and Sukhothai Airport: not over 400.-Thai baht;

(c) Trat Airport: not over 200.-Thai baht;

(d) [§]Krabi Airport, Surat Thani Airport,

Ubon Ratchathani Airport, Khon Kaen Airport,

Nakhon Si Thammarat Airport, and

Phitsanulok Airport: not over 75.- Thai baht;

(e) ^{**}other aerodromes under responsibility of

Department of Airports; and

other aerodromes besides

those specified in (a), (b), (c), and (d): not over 50.- Thai baht;
