



Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand
on Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material: AMC/GM
of the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand
on Air Operations Standards for the Air Operator
(Thailand Civil Aviation Regulation - Air Operations (TCAR OPS))

Whereas the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand issued the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material: AMC/GM of the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Air Operations Standards for the Air Operator (Thailand Civil Aviation Regulation - Air Operations (TCAR OPS)), B.E. 2567 (2024), issued on 20 December 2024, and it is expedient to update such means to ensure that they remain current and consistent with the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Air Operations Standards for the Air Operator (Thailand Civil Aviation Regulation - Air Operations (TCAR OPS)), B.E. 2567 (2024), as amended, the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand hereby issues this Notification prescribing the “Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material” as follows:

Clause 1: This Notification shall be called the “Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material: AMC/GM of the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Air Operations Standards for the Air Operator (Thailand Civil Aviation Regulation - Air Operations (TCAR OPS)), B.E. 2567 (2024) (No. 2), B.E. 2569 (2026).”

Clause 2: The following shall be repealed:

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Guidance Material to TCAR OPS Part Organisation Requirements for Air Operations (AMC/GM to TCAR OPS Part-ORO) Issue 02 Revision 01 Date 26 August 2026, annexed to this Notification.

(2) Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to TCAR OPS Part Commercial Air Transport (AMC/GM to TCAR OPS Part-CAT) Issue 02 Revision 00 Date 20 December 2024, annexed to the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material: AMC/GM of the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Air Operations Standards for the Air Operator (Thailand Civil Aviation Regulation - Air Operations (TCAR OPS)), B.E. 2567 (2024), issued on 20 December 2024, and shall be replaced by Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material to TCAR OPS Part Commercial Air Transport (AMC/GM to TCAR OPS Part-CAT) Issue 02 Revision 01 Date 26 August 2026, annexed to this Notification.
